Dear Kansas State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue Judges,

Thank you so much for agreeing to serve as a judge at this year's Kansas State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue. I appreciate your expertise and willingness to work with our 4-H young people as they continue to learn and refine their skills and knowledge as it pertains to clothing, textiles, and consumer economics. I have outlined many of the details for the day below. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you have any questions!

**PROCEDURE:**

You will judge alone. Contestants will generally come in groups of five, and you'll have approximately five minutes per contestant. We tried to group them in similar type outfits, but that was not always possible.

**RIBBON PLACEMENT:**

We will use white, red, blue, and purple ribbons. We name a champion, reserve champion and three honorable mentions in each division. There will be two judges for Construction and Young Men's Buymanship and three judges for Young Women's Buymanship. For each division the judges will get together at the end to determine the champion, reserve champion and three honorable mentions from their purple winners in each of the three respective classes. There is time on the schedule for call backs where the division judges and all division call backs will gather in one room.

**CALL BACK PROCEDURE:**

You will need to let your clerk know your purples at the end of each judging group, so the purple winners will know they are to return for the champion/reserve champion selections. **This announcement needs to be made before the youth leave the room.** ALL purples will be called back for champion/reserve champion selections.

**CLERKS:**

Each one of you will have a clerk to assist you and handle the paperwork. Even though you may visit verbally with the members, please give some comments in writing on the evaluation sheet. These will be given to the members.

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**EVALUATION SCORE SHEET:**

A copy of the score sheet that will be used is enclosed. Please review the Standards on the top of the enclosed example. This is what you should be evaluating against.

The contestants will have already answered these questions on their scorecard. You will complete the bottom section as your scorecard. Note that you will score and evaluate their knowledge of some aspects of wardrobe planning and care, as well as their ability to calculate Cost per Wear. The form used for figuring cost per wear is on the back of the score sheet.

Please be sure those who have received white and red ribbons know why they rated low. Blue ribbon winners also wonder why they didn't get a purple, so please let them know your thoughts as to how they could improve. Please remember that these need to be constructive comments that you as a parent would like to read on your child's comment sheet.
