#### A Proud Past, A Promising Future

- 2010 Census Population 2,184 (UP 13% since 2000)
- 24.2% college educated, 82.5% high school or GED
  - KS 30.7% college education, 90% HS or equivalency
- 72.1% family households, 27.9% non-family
- Poverty rate is 13.9% (KS=13.8%)
- Median Age 34.2 years (36)
- Median household income is \$51,375 (\$51,872)




#### K-STATE Research and Extension

- Excellent customer service- we ate lunch at Richie's even though everyone we talked to suggested Ingalls or Montezuma for really good food!






## Other Retail Shopping Areas

#### **Health Care Services**

- Mostly evident by visiting with residents:
  - "Well-staffed Medical Clinic"
  - Physical therapy clinic, Chiropractic, EMS services supplied locally
  - Clark's Drug (Pharmacy)

Two long term care facilities observed. One which was just completing construction.







#### Housing

- There are 789 housing units
- 703 are occupied (89%)
- Owner Occupied: 440 (63%) (KS=67.1%)
- Renter Occupied: 263 (37%)
- (KS = 32.9%)












- Your pride is evident from the quality and maintenance of the structures
- No printed materials tell us why you're so proud of your schools.











#### **Childcare**

- We did not see public childcare in our drivethrough observations.
- "Roughly 5 or more childcare services are available for community members."
- "The lady we talked to at the library indicated there is a need for more childcare."

 Multiple well-kept churches and denominations, but no signs at the edge of town.



No evidence of church-sponsored activities.








#### Civic

 We were looking for evidence of civic groups; this was the only evidence we found.





#### **Public Infrastructure**

- A recurring comment is the lack of signage.
- All visitors commented favorably on the overall condition of sidewalks, parking, landscaping and street-scaping.



 All of our visits occurred during the daylight hours, so we can not comment on adequacy of the street lighting.



## **City Hall**

- Convenient downtown location.
- Difficult to locate during the time visitors were there. "We had to ask many people" where city hall was.



- All 3 visitors commented on how helpful the new City Clerk was
- There wasn't much print information to inform visitors.



## **Police/Fire Protection**

- Visitors learned that there is a volunteer fire department for the community
- Sheriff services the community and is located at the Gray County Courthouse in Cimarron

- An abundance of books and periodicals








- Trees are beautiful and appealing.
