It is now up to you to go on-line and complete the national application. The Alpha Rho Chapter will host the ESP National Meeting October 1-4, 2018 in Manhattan. As a host chapter, we would love to have 100% of our chapter membership attending. For many, we know the local unit or department budget might not allow for that travel and so our planning committee, headed up by Stacey Warner and Jennifer Wilson, submitted a grant application to the ESP Kansas Extension Endowment Fund to help with National Meeting expenses through scholarships. The Kansas Extension Endowment Fund has awarded \$10,000 to the Alpha Rho Chapter for registration scholarships for members to attend the 2018 National Epsilon Sigma Phi Conference to be held in Manhattan October 1-4. All chapter members, including life members, are encouraged to apply for the scholarships.

Scholarships: will be awarded in the following amounts:

*Full amount of early-bird registration for first time national conference attendees.

*Half of early-bird registration for those who have attended a national conference previously.

Preference: Scholarships will be awarded with the following preference.

*First time conference attendees.

*Those for whom receipt of the scholarship would financially be a determining factor for attendance.

*Involvement in the Alpha Rho Chapter.

Application Process: To apply, outline the following in a pdf document and send to: <u>jrwilson@ksu.edu</u> by February 28.

*Name, email address

*Alpha Rho Chapter involvement: officer, committee member, endowment grant recipient, recognition recipient, etc.

*A paragraph outlining reasons desiring to attend the conference.

*A statement about previous national conference attendance.

*A statement about whether or not receipt of this scholarship would be a determining factor in attendance at the conference.

Timeline: The application deadline is February 28. Awardees will be announced about March 20
