- Utilize email, phone calls, and other communication channels to engage members.
- Collaborate with the KBFA newsletter team and other outreach platforms to promote survey completion.
- Track outreach efforts and maintain organized records of responses.
- Assist in compiling and organizing survey data for integration into the internal membership directory.
- Support KBFA in fostering stronger connections among Black farmers in Kansas and Missouri.
- Conduct interviews with farmers in our membership involved in the survey project to create informative story narratives
- Create and present a final presentation deck on the discoveries and accomplishments during the fellowship
