



#### **About This Role:**

K-State Research and Extension Reno County in partnership with K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems is seeking a Local Food Fellow to complete the local food system project: Ark Valley Food Circle Local Food Directory.

This part time, 16-week fellowship will run from February 12 to May 31, 2024 (dates are flexible).

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Travel to visit and interview local producers, processors, and vendors in Reno County to gather information about their food products and how consumers can purchase them. Input that information into a database.
- Create a local foods directory of Reno County and nearby producers using a word processing program.
- Create a printed directory of local producers.
- Create an online directory that can be updated as needed.
- Complete final report to be submitted to K-State Research and Extension Local Food Systems Program Coordinator before finishing fellowship period.

This directory will help address the growing desire of consumers to find healthy, locally produced foods. It will also support producers' ability to connect with the community to share their products and how to purchase them.
