TULSA AND OKLAHOMA CITY

- Top 10 state for entrepreneurs in 2022
- More than 10 high-quality startup accelerator/incubator programs
- Entrepreneurship rate 57% higher than Kansas in 2021

MADISON, WISCONSIN

- Running multiple accelerators per year for newly formed and scaling startups
- 42% rise in startup formation since 2019 and 76 percent increase in private risk capital deployed to fuel startups
- At the height of the pandemic, gained 1.77 tech workers for each one who left the city (May - Oct 2020)





Impact to Date

In partnership with NetWork Kansas, this program continues to expand its reach and impact year over year.

51 Entrepreneurs Served Over 3 Years

- 79% had minority or female founders
- 17% Black or African American
- 8% Asian or Asian American
- 23% Hispanic or Latino
- 6% Native American or Alaska Native
- 8% had veterans and/or disabilities
- All startups were from Kansas
- 43% operate in underserved, rural or urban distressed Kansas

NXTSTAGE Enterprise Engagement Series

Bridging the communication & knowledge gaps between established organizations and early-stage companies who want to grow by selling B2B.

- Weekly, 90-minute, open-discussion workshops
- Access to 1-on-1 meetings with enterprises
- An Enterprise Playbook provided by each partner with a guide to doing business with them
- Stipend at the end of the program, no equity taken
- The Startup-Enterprise Summit culminating occurs during Wichita Startup Week and puts startups in front of nearly 200 attendees

Impact to Date

The inaugural program connected a cohort of 20 KS entrepreneurs and 11 Enterprise Partners, expanded reach in partnership with NetWork Kansas.

40 Cohort Members Graduated In First Two Years

- 83% of the diverse cohort selected had minority or female founders
- 8% Veteran Founders
- 8% Hispanic or Latino
- 15% Black or African American
- 8% Asian or Asian American
- 3% Native American or Alaska Native
- 40% with Opportunity Zone Zip Codes
- 40% operate in underserved, rural or urban distressed Kansas
